Chicken Pox

There has been a case of chickenpox of a child that attends the centre.

Chickenpox is a viral illness that comes on suddenly and is highly contagious. The chickenpox virus is also called *varicella virus*. Chickenpox usually starts with one spot, but more quickly appear, with fever, headache, runny nose, a cough and feeling very tired. The rash starts on the chest and back and spreads to the face, scalp, arms and legs. The rash can develop all over the body,

inside the ears, on the eyelids, inside the nose and within the vagina, everywhere. The rash continues to spread for three or four days. It is usually very itchy. **Exclusion period**

Exclude until all blisters have dried. This is usually at least 5 days after the rash first appeared in unimmunised children and less in immunised children.

Hand foot and mouth

There has also been a case of hand foot and mouth

Symptoms include a slight fever, loss of appetite, blisters in the mouth and on the hands and feet, and a sore mouth for a few days before the ulcers or blisters appear. Affected young children may refuse to eat or drink. Less commonly, blisters may be seen in the nappy area. Hand, foot and mouth disease is spread through contact with the fluid in the blisters. This is most likely to occur when the virus becomes airborne during coughing, singing, talking, etc. Contact with faeces can also **Exclusion period** Exclude until all blisters have dried.
