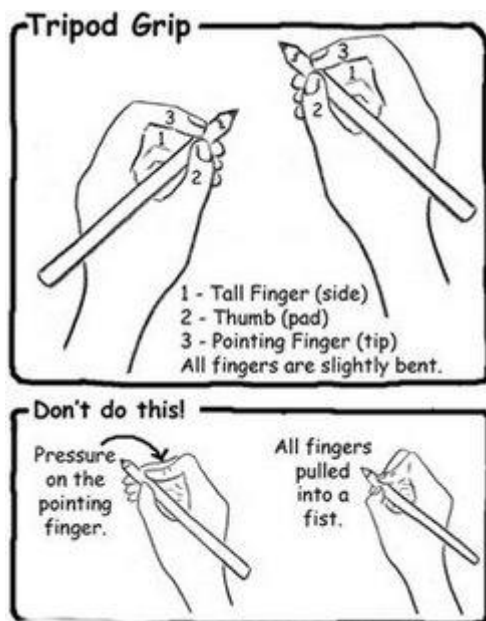

Showing Children how to hold a pencil



Show children how to hold a pencil while they draw and write with you. It is very important for you to help your child to develop the correct pencil grip. The first few days are going to be challenging. The proper grip felt "funny" and he had less pencil control, but it is better for long term if he can hold a pencil correctly. The pencil should be positioned so that there is equal pressure between the thumb, the side of the middle finger and the tip of the index finger. All fingers are bent slightly. This is called a "tripod grip" or "tripod pencil grasp".

Raising Children

Raising Children have a website with lots of information on raising children. We have the DVD at

the centre for you to borrow or you can get onto their website raisingchildren.net.au Here is one of their recipes you might like to try.

Lead by example. If you want your child to eat their fruit and veg, make sure they see you enjoying yours on a regular basis.

Carrot and muesli mini muffins Makes 24



150 gm self raising flour
150 gm mixed fruit muesli
180 gm carrots, grated (about 2 medium carrots)
100 gm brown sugar
½ tsp cinnamon
2 eggs
150 ml olive oil

1. Preheat oven to 180°C. Lightly oil a 24-hole mini muffin tin.
2. In a large bowl, combine flour, muesli, grated carrot, sugar and cinnamon. Mix to combine. Lightly whisk eggs and add to oil. Pour into carrot mixture and mix until just combined (do not over mix).
3. Spoon evenly into the muffin tin and bake in the preheated oven for 12-15 minutes or until a skewer inserted comes out clean.
4. Allow to rest in the tin for 5 minutes before turning out and cooling on a wire rack
