Free eye screening service for 3 to 5 year olds

If your child does not attend on the Tuesday they are still very welcome to attend the eye screening service but need to be accompanied by an adult.

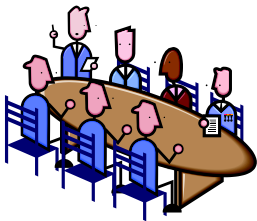
