123 Magic

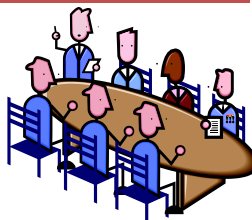

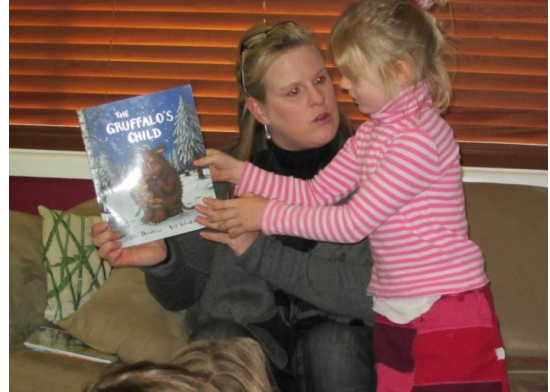
